And their inheritance shall be forever.* Psalm 37:18

Psalm 37:18

Remember that Psalm 37 is not a “lament,” it is instruction on how to navigate during times when the wicked seem to prosper.

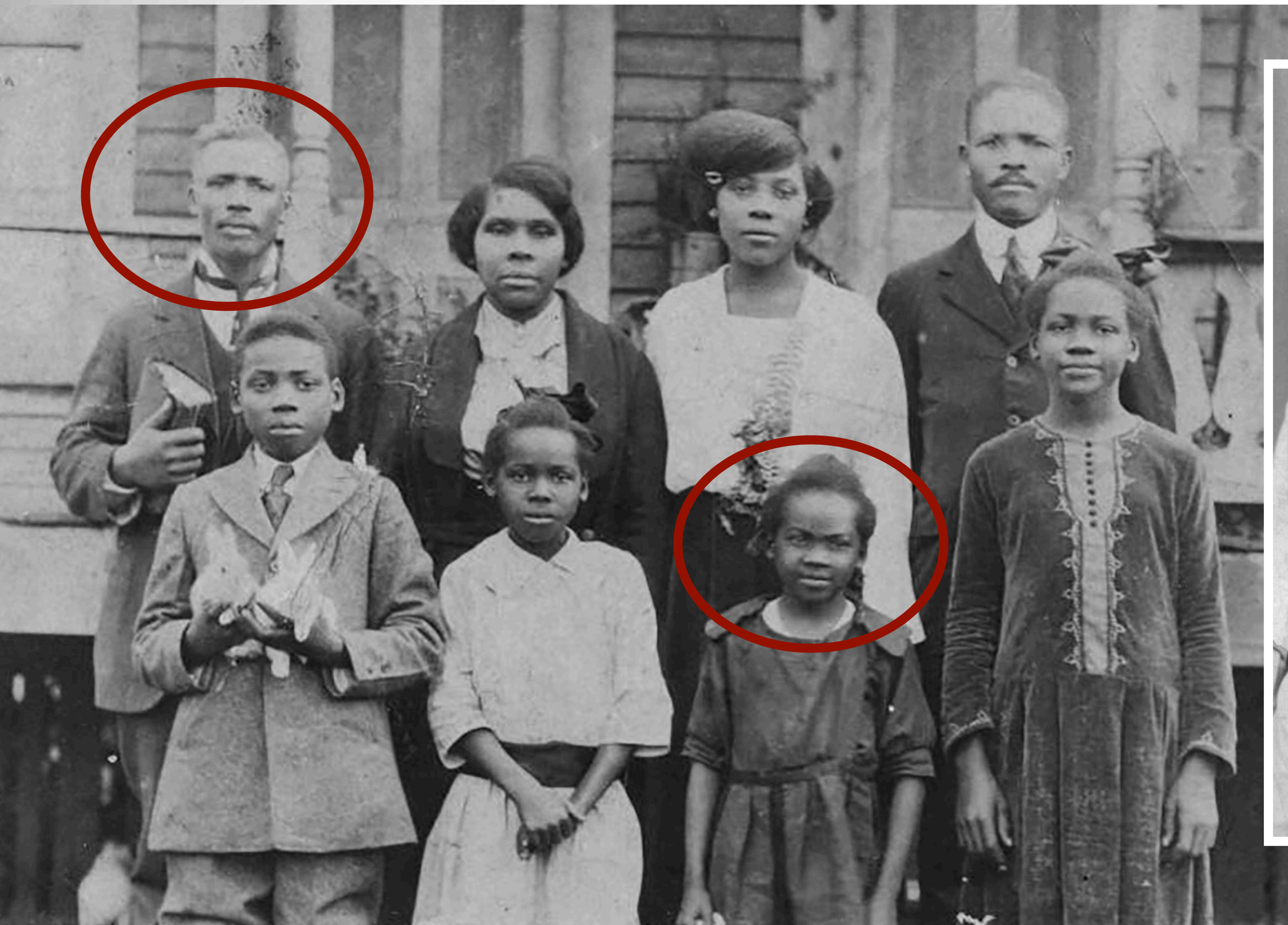
“The LORD knows the days of the upright”

- Cares for you.

God sees our days over the entire span of life

- We think of days in terms of calendar, special events, conditions
- God sees days as seasons. including seasons of ease and seasons of hardship.

The Lord sees seasons because He is a generational God



“Their inheritance shall be forever.”

Long after we are gone and forgotten, God remembers our days and what those days produced in the Earth and in the lives of others.

“Their inheritance shall be forever”

- Inheritance is not only material things handed down to us
- Inheritance is also what we have from the Lord that we provide to others.
- God Himself as the ultimate inheritance

“Their inheritance shall be forever”

- Most of our ancestors did not have the material possessions that we have.
- Many had something much greater:
- They had faith in God, integrity, talents, and the will to overcome and succeed.
