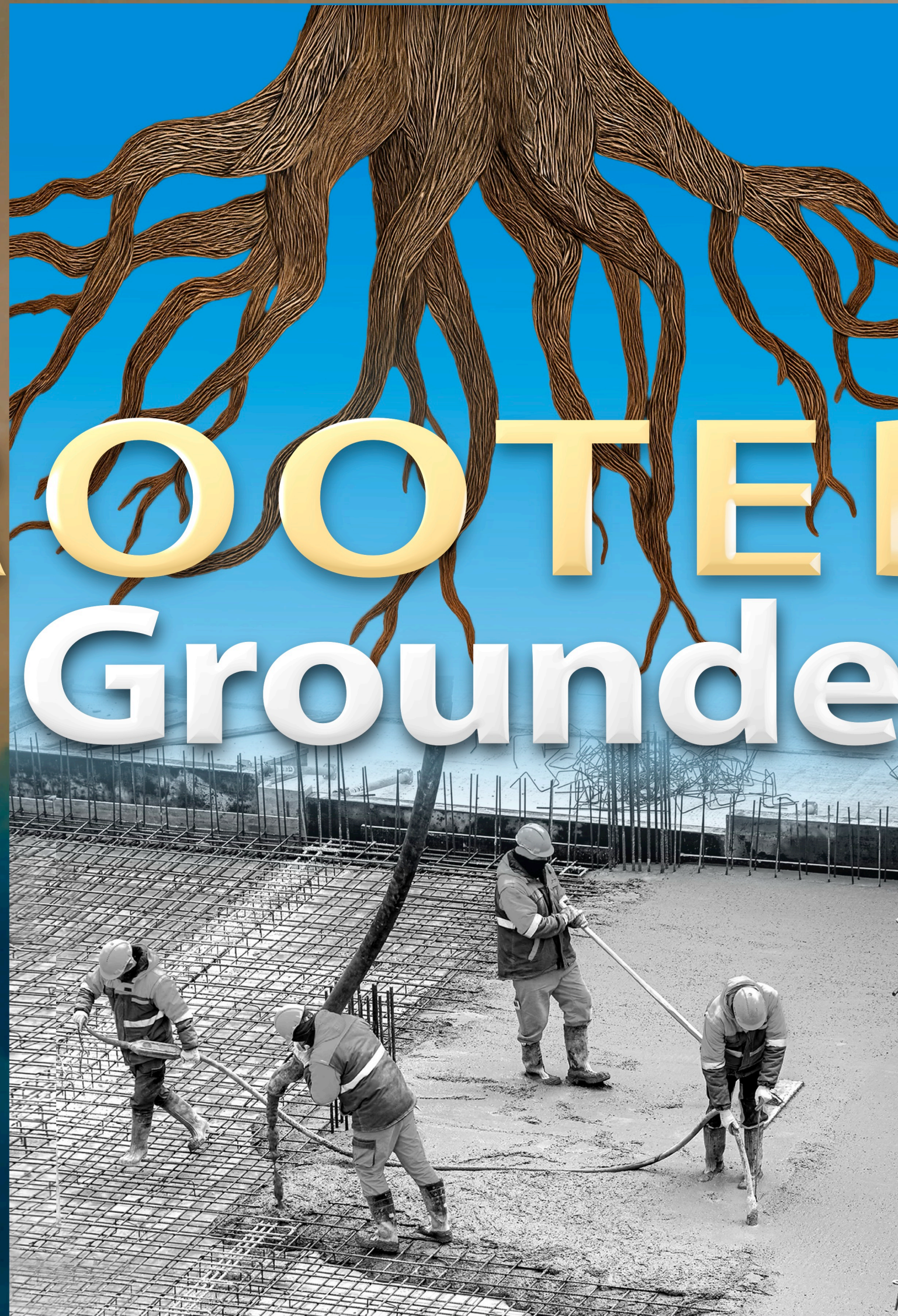




## **Ephesians 3:14**

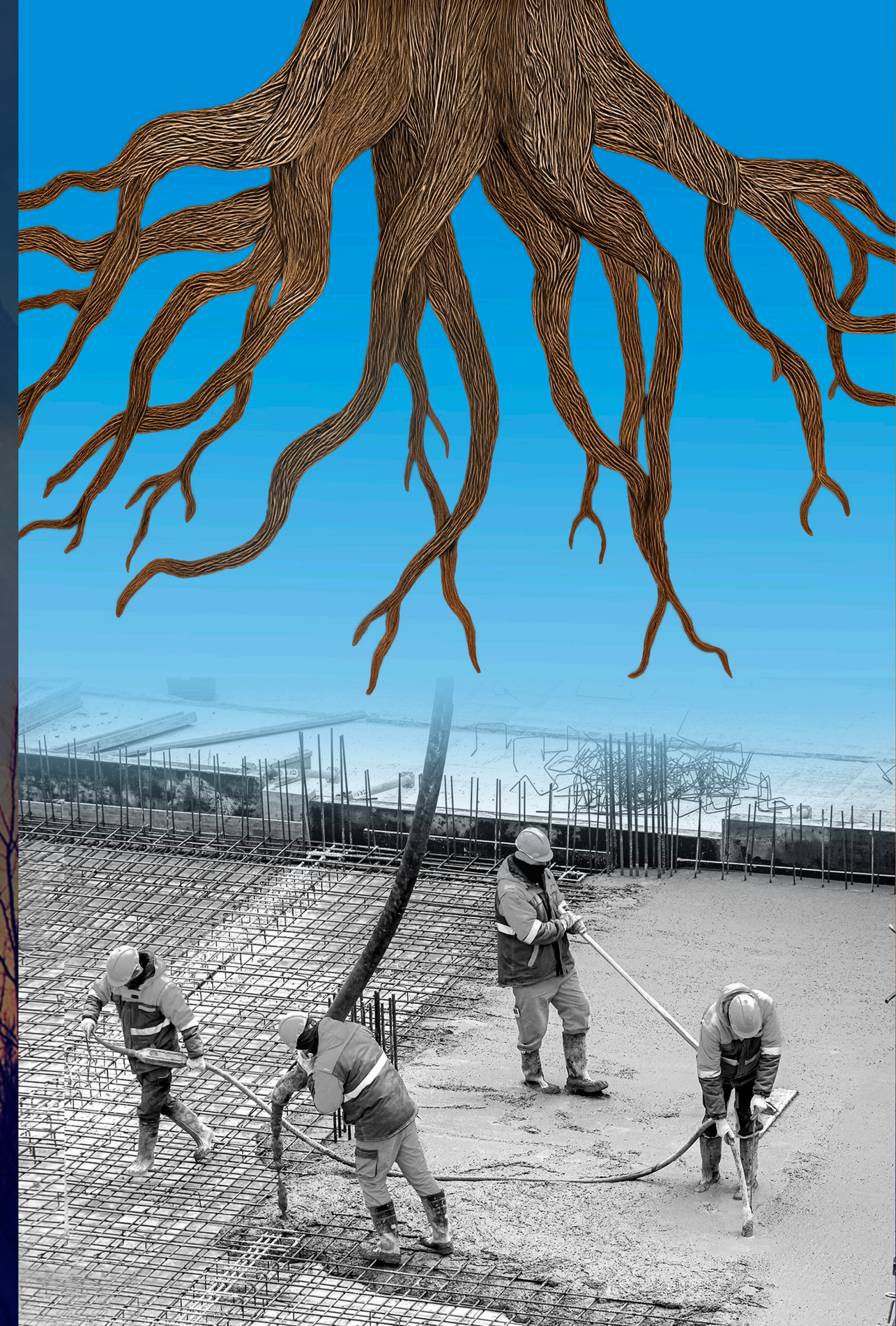

**“ROOTED”** is an agricultural term

Like a building, the believer’s life must have a solid foundation.


Without **roots**, there is no growth.

Understanding ***“The power that works in us”***  
***“Dunamis”*** - Defined as “Dynamite” (Swedish use of Greek word named by Alfred Nobel), ability, inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth.



One of the worst feelings that we can have is a feeling of powerlessness. Beware of that feeling...

2 Corinthians 2:11, *Lest Satan should take advantage of us; for **we are not ignorant of his devices.***

Satan is seeking to take advantage, so don't be ignorant. One of Satan's devices is to remove your sense of **agency.**



**Agency** is the ability or power to:


Act, make decisions, choose, and make things happen—to influence your own life and environment rather than being controlled by others or by circumstances.

**Agency** is part of the essence of being Imago Dei (made in God's image)



The closest word we have in the Bible  
to agency is **dominion**

**Genesis 1:26**, Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth. 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.





During the 250th year anniversary of our nation, we are going to hear a lot of stories. Many will be fabrications and romanticized notions.

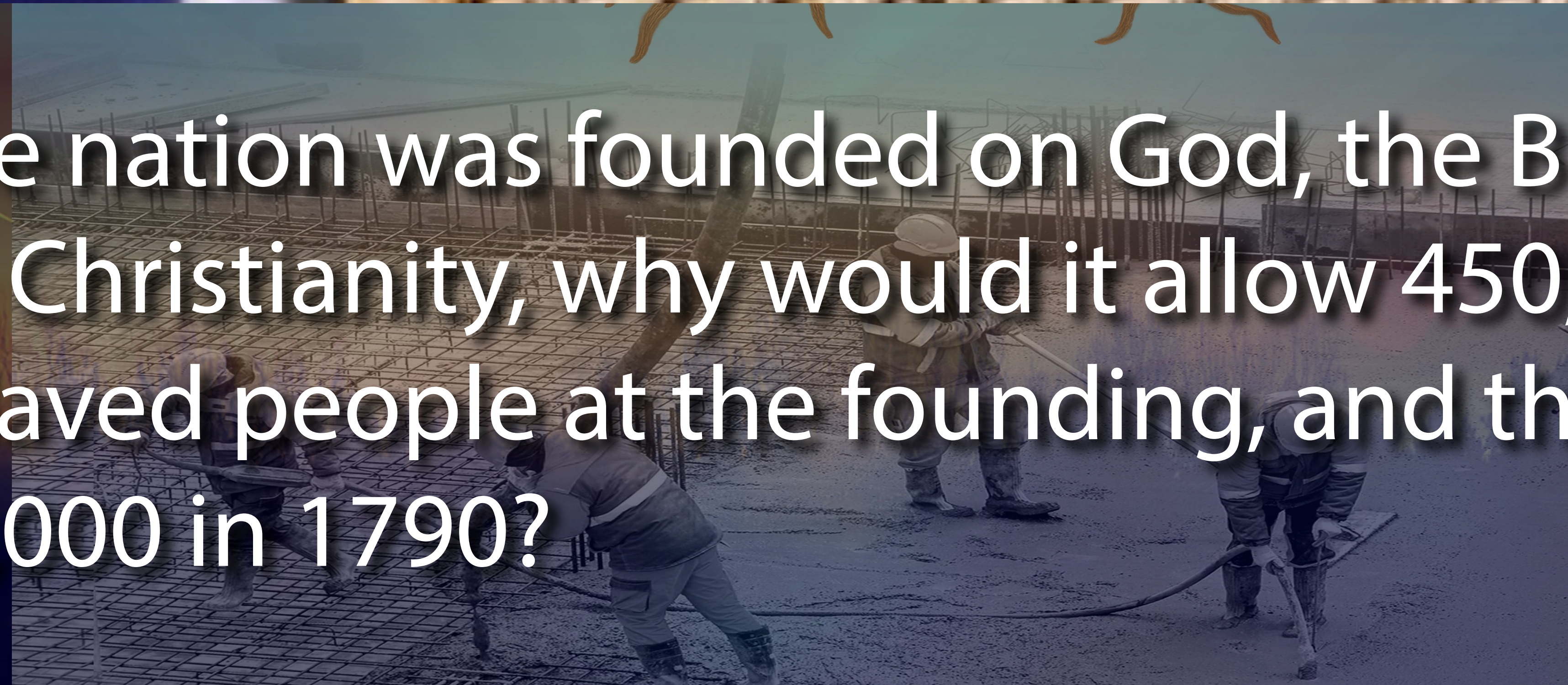
# #Facts



- In 1776, there were approximately 2.5 million total population.
- In 1776, there were approximately 450,000 enslaved people among the population.
- First official U.S. Census in 1790 counted 3.9 million population.
- The same census counted approximately 700,000 enslaved people.
- That 18% of the people made in God's image and likeness were enslaved **and had no AGENCY**



If the nation was founded on God, the Bible, and Christianity, why would it allow 450,000 enslaved people at the founding, and then 700,000 in 1790?

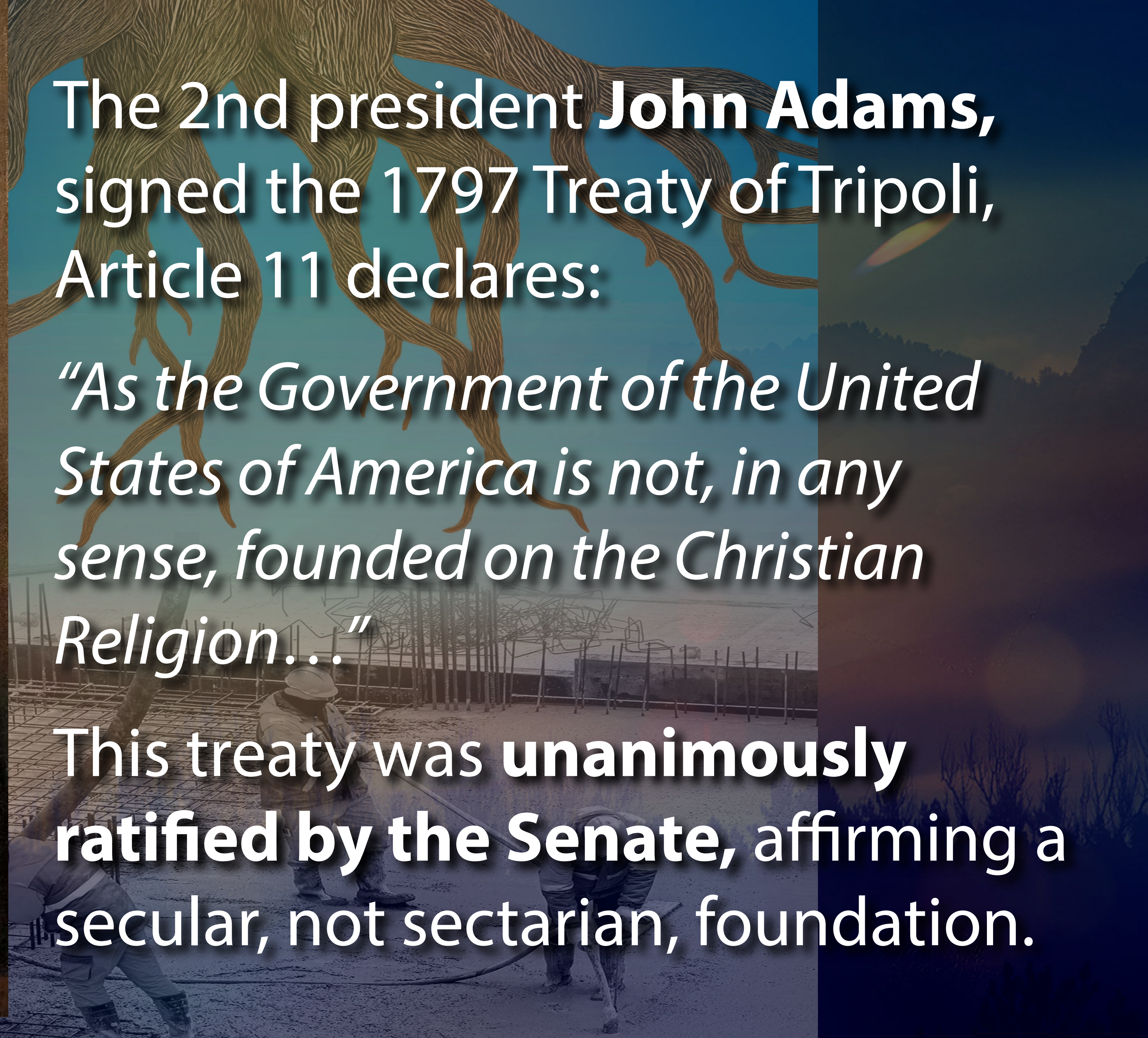




The 2nd president **John Adams**, signed the 1797 Treaty of Tripoli, Article 11 declares:

*“As the Government of the United States of America is not, in any sense, founded on the Christian Religion...”*

This treaty was **unanimously ratified by the Senate**, affirming a secular, not sectarian, foundation.
